Online Course about Online Courses for Advisors



The new online advisors' course has completed its Fall 2016 offering. Fifty-one advisors enrolled in two sessions of the course. In the program evaluations 100 percent of the participants reported being satisfied with the course, with 76.5 reporting that they were extremely satisfied.

Many advisors reported that they liked experiencing a "small piece of what students experience in an online course."

Collaboration with Regional Campuses?



Digital Education participated in the Provost's Purdue System Summit by conducting a workshop exploring the potential for collaboration in digital education among the Purdue campuses. Areas discussed included system-wide online courses, shared online programs, shared technology, training and development for online instructors, student orientation to online courses, and online support for international study.
