Graduate Assistantships in Instructional Design



ITaP's Teaching and Learning Technologies group has established two graduate assistantships in instructional design to create opportunities for Purdue students in this field to gain experience. The assistantships are 12-month appointments with tuition remissions. One assistantship is focused on developing a research compendium for best practices for teaching and learning with technology, and the second on developing instructional media, using 3D modeling, augmented reality and animations. Quality Matters Training Workshop



Digital Education and Teaching Learning Technologies will offer a one-day training workshop on Quality Matters (QM) on June 6, 2017. With over 1,000 institutions worldwide using its rubric to benchmark quality, QM is the leading quality assurance system for online courses. QM uses research-derived

Purdue New University

On April 27th, Purdue announced the acquisition of Kaplan University as a bold move forward to further expand online access to higher education. The initiative addresses the need for postsecondary education for working adults and others unsuited to traditional campus study, and the explosive growth of online technologies as a means of delivering education to students of all types. Purdue will acquire the academic operations and assets of Kaplan University, including its 15 campuses and learning centers, 32,000 students, 3,000 employees and decades of experience in distance education. Almost all of these students are in fully online programs, and all existing Kaplan University students and faculty will transition to the new university, which will use the Purdue name in some fashion not yet identified. This will be a separate, self-supporting campus of the Purdue system. More info at <http://www.purduenewu.org>.
